What will I study?

In this course, you will explore digital film and video production skills through units of study including Film Production (Fiction), Single Camera Techniques, Film Editing and Stop-Motion Animation.

In Year 13, you will create your own digital media film production to demonstrate the skills you have learned. This is an exciting opportunity to develop practical filmmaking skills and make use of the dedicated film and TV studio at SBL Academy under expert guidance.

If you want to make your own high-quality, professional products for social media or dream of working in the film industry, this is an ideal course for you!

Assessment

Five units in total, including four internally assessed units and one externally assessed unit at the end of the course

Study trips, visits and events

Trips to industry events such as the BBC Natural History Careers Day, visits from industry professionals, and opportunities to present your own media productions to real audiences.

4 in Maths, **plus** 4 in either English Literature **or** Language.
